

**NYE COUNTY  
PAHRUMP JUSTICE COURT**

**ILLEGAL PARKING**

Due to the changes in the Nevada Legislature this year (2019), the Pahrump Justice Court will begin amending certain moving traffic violations to Illegal Parking and no Memorandum of Plea will be required from the District Attorney's Office.

**REQUIREMENTS FOR NEGOTIATIONS:**

Individuals seeking to have their citation amended to Illegal Parking MUST pay their citation in full prior to the due date indicated on the citation.

**ATTORNEYS:**

Attorneys MUST file a properly formatted Designation of Counsel with the Court and provide representation to the court they can enter a plea on defendant's behalf. Once the court has received those and payment in full, prior to the citation due date, the violation will be amended.

**VIOLATIONS THAT DO NOT QUALIFY FOR NEGOTIATIONS:**

- Driving Under the Influence (DUI)
- Reckless Driving
- Aggressive Driving
- Road Rage
- No CDL Violations (that occur while in the truck)
- No Accidents
- No School Zone Violations
- No Construction Violations
- No Speeding 21+ Miles Per Hour (mph) Over the Limit

**DISCLAIMERS:**

If your citation has already entered in the Failure to Appear (FTA) process, you no longer qualify for the Court's negotiations and you will have to set a hearing to negotiate your citation. Also, the Court will only allow a maximum of three (3) Illegal Parking violations per year.

Any citations not meeting this criteria can be taken to the judges on a case by case basis for review. And if an attorney has filed a Designation of Counsel for a cite that does not qualify for negotiations, the matter would be set for a Pre-Trial Hearing.
