NRS 4.157 requires that each justice court having more than one (1) justice of the peace select a chief judge to adopt rules and regulations necessary for the orderly conduct of court business. Pahrump Justice Court general administrative order 2022-01, issued on February 28, 2022, appointed Justice of the Peace Lisa Chamlee as chief judge of the Pahrump Justice Court. Accordingly, this administrative order is hereby issued:

On May 6, 2022, Nevada Governor Steve Sisolak announced his intention to end the State of Emergency related to the COVID-19 pandemic on May 20, 2022.

Accordingly, the Pahrump Justice Court hereby issues the following changes to its previous Covid-19 Administrative Orders, effective May 20, 2022:

1. The Court will conduct all civil and criminal hearings in person, with litigants, defendants, counsel, and witnesses appearing in the courtroom, with masks being optional. Social distancing measurements will no longer be utilized. All litigants must appear in court in person unless the court has approved the litigant or counsel to appear electronically. Any litigant or attorney who does not wish to appear in person must orally or in writing request to appear by electronic means with the Justice Court at least one (1) judicial day before the trial/hearing date and must serve the opposing party with a copy of the written

request to appear by electronic means. Approval must be granted by the court or an appearance in person is required.

All other provisions set forth in the Court's previous Covid-19 Administrative Orders, which are not expressly modified or vacated by this Order are hereby rescinded.
